2 x d&b 1220 in the Stagetowers (L/R) for roughly monitoring
the Mainstage.

Microphones and DI: We provide the most common Microphones and DI Boxes for Sound reinforcement and Recording, in a decent number. Normally we are pretty close to Guest-Rider demands.

We do not provide any exotic microphones (i.e. Hydrophones, Dummy Heads).

Misc: Power, Power Cables, XLR and Stands are self-evident.
